



LAZY CAMPER INFO

SIR STEWART BOVELL PARK,
BUSSELTON

DIRECTIONS

If you are driving to the festival, free parking is available on the farm next to Sir Stewart Bovell Park. Access the parking area via **Gates C or D** (refer to the parking map). Parking on the verge of either Vasse or Bussell Highways or in any of the surrounding streets is **strictly prohibited** and may attract a hefty fine from the local ranger. Please **NO SMOKING** in the carpark or anywhere on the farm as this is a fire risk.

ENTRY

Once at the camp gate, proceed through bag check and head to the **Lazy Camper entry lane**. You will be wristbanded, then directed to the Lazy camper area (refer to the camping info map). You must be 18 years or over to access the camping area.

LAZY CAMPING

When you arrive at the Lazy Camper area you will receive a numbered tag that matches the number of your tent.

Here's what you get, which will be set up and waiting for you when you arrive:

- A two-person tent (as advised when you purchased your ticket, you will need to share with one other person)
- An air mattress

Please bring your own linen/sleeping bag and also your own pillow

Unpack your gear, meet your new tent buddy (if you are arriving on your own), then kick back and enjoy your Lazy Camper festival experience.

Please remember that we cannot reserve tents for other people, so if you want to bunk with a friend, you **MUST** check in to the Lazy Camper area together.

DEPARTING

There is no need to pack up your tent – please just leave your tent as you found it. Make sure you leave all the camping equipment as it remains the property of Sunset Events. But please do take your rubbish with you and put it in the recycling bins as you leave.
